SLPS Placement Process for Student Teachers, Interns, and Observers

STEP 1: University Responsibility

University submits request via link **SLPS.org/StudentTeach**

Student Teaching Practicum Observation Internship

STEP 2: University Responsibility

University informs student of placement requirements and sends an email to StudentTeach@SLPS.org

STEP 4: Placements (Recruitment Team Responsibility)

Recruitment team will review student's application and the university's request. Once verified, Recruitment Team will send an email to the student and forward information to university and partner school's principal. University, principal or supervisor, and student determine collaboratively the logistics of placement.

If student applicants do not have all required information uploaded in Nimble application, the Recruitment Team will notify the student and university by email of the missing documentation. Once application is updated, student and/or university need(s) to reply to email that required information is uploaded and application is complete.
