Logging Into Parent Portal
 1. Go to this website: <https://sis.slps.org/SLPS360x3/login> (type exactly as shown).
 2. Click the Parent tab on the screen (make sure you are under "Parent" or it will not log in).
 3. Enter the email address that is on file in SIS and the password you created.

Intent to Return
 1. A yellow notification should appear, saying you have forms to complete.
 2. Click the notification bar to access and complete the forms for all your scholars.
 3. Complete the form between [redacted] to secure priority transportation routes.

Please follow the steps to secure your child(ren)'s spot for next school year. This registration is good for any SLPS location. 5th Grade Student Families must complete now for Middle School. It is better to complete now and change your mind, then risk losing priority by waiting. Completing your registration now makes your child(ren) priority for seating, transportation, and aftercare services. The application process is 100% online. 
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Saturday School

A contract needs to be signed by each student's parent or legal guardian. iPads cannot be given out to the students until the contract is signed. As the weather changes, there may be a need for an Alternate Methods of Instruction (AMI) Day and only students with a signed contract will be able to take devices home. Any student who does not have a contract on file signed, will go home with a learning packet.

All students must have their device to take all mandatory assessments, State Exams, and to complete and submit class assignments. Uniforms & Cell Phone Policy Reminders

Columbia is a uniform school. All students must wear their uniforms Monday-Thursday. Dress down day is every Friday. Students may wear any color uniform top or bottom. Students can wear the shoes of their choice. Students/Staff may wear jeans every Friday. Students are not able to use cell phones during the school day and/or during the before care/after school programs. Columbia will not be responsible for lost or stolen phones. If students are caught using a cell phone during the school day, without permission, the phone will be confiscated, and the parent/guardian will be required to pick it up from administration.

Arrival

Friendly Reminders:

- Students are not allowed inside the building before 8:05 AM (unless they are enrolled in Before Care). ***Please do not leave students unattended anywhere on our school grounds. If this happens, the school will be required to make a hotline call, as we are mandated reporters. Students must always be supervised.***
- Students should enter through the following doors 8:05 AM - 8:15 AM:

Door #7: PreK

Door #9: 1st – 5th grade

Door #13: KG/Inclement Weather Entrance/Exit

- PreK students check-in and report to their teacher’s classroom. 1st - 5th grade students should enter the Gym and be seated in their class lines.
- Classroom teachers will escort students to the cafeteria, through the food service line, and then to eat breakfast in their classroom.
- Students arriving after 8:15 AM should check into the Main Office (enter through Door #1), receive grab-and-go breakfast from cafeteria, and report to class.

Due to safety, parents are NOT allowed to stay with children. Parents must complete a volunteer application, and it must be processed at Central Office prior to volunteering in the classroom
