Arrival

Friendly Reminders:

- Students are not allowed inside the building before 8:05 AM (unless they are enrolled in Before Care).
- Students should enter through the following doors 8:05 AM 8:15 AM:

Door #7: PreK

Door #9: 1st - 5th grade

Door #13: KG/Inclement Weather Entrance/Exit

- PreK students check-in and report to their teacher's classroom. 1st 5th grade students should enter the Gym and be seated in their class lines.
- Classroom teachers will escort students to the cafeteria, through the food service line, and then to eat breakfast in their classroom.
- Students arriving after 8:15 AM should check into the Main Office (enter through Door #1), receive grab-and-go breakfast from cafeteria, and report to class.

Due to safety, parents are NOT allowed to stay with children. Parents must complete a volunteer application, and it must be processed at Central Office prior to volunteering in the classroom

All students must ride the bus/alternate transportation or be picked up by 3:17 PM daily.

Sports Update

Students in grades 3rd -5th are invited to practice and participate on the Columbia Elementary Soccer Team. Students MUST have a physical on file with the nurse prior to participating. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) should complete the Soccer Team Participation Forms and Student Code of Conduct Forms and return to Principal Houston (tiffany.houston@slps.org), Coach Sechrest (ashtin.sechrest@slps.org), or the main office.



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District Soccer Team Information

- 1. All games will be played at Collegiate School of Medicine and Bioscience High School (located at 4939 Kemper Ave.).
- 2. There is an admission charge of \$4 for anyone who wants to attend the games. (the district remains 100% cashless)- there is an option to buy a multiple scan pass for the regular season 6 scans for \$20 or 15 scans for \$40. Please purchase single tickets the morning of the games before arrival so it is a seamless entry.
- 3. Fans must bring their own chairs/seats as bleachers are not available.
- 4. Security Policy- Only small clutches for bags are allowed.
- 5. Sports You for families- This will help catch those families if we need to cancel for any reason or those fans that are not directly in contact with your school, helps promote our sports programming as they can post pictures and comments.
- 6. Students must have a physical on file with Nurse Dawson.

Columbia Soccer Team Information

- 1. Soccer Practice will take place Monday-Thursday during after-school hours.
- 2. Students can wear tennis shoes but are encouraged to wear cleats.
- 3. Students must wear black shorts/bottoms for all games.
- 4. Students will not be able to participate in practice/games if they do not have good behavior or have not completed assignments during the school week.
- 5. Parents/Guardians are required to provide transportation to all games (they occur on Saturdays). Students can be dropped off to games but must be picked up on time (Games typically last 1 hour).

Families can cheer students on during games and can have signs to display and noise makers. Remember this is only elementary school sports, we won't win every game. We are exposing our students to sports and teaching them good sportsmanship, please support this effort.

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Transportation

Opt-Out from Transportation: We are asking families who can transport students to school on their own to commit to this practice for the school year. Many have already chosen this option, and freeing up the seats on the bus for others will allow for more efficiency. Please go to www.slps.org/optout for more information.

Bus Stop Consolidation: A significant challenge we face in ensuring buses arrive on time is the current number of stops. Our plan includes safely and thoughtfully reducing the number of bus stops to address this issue. We are assessing stops across the district as part of this plan.

Strategic routing: We have been collaborating closely with a transportation consulting firm, 4Mativ Technologies, to analyze our transportation system and develop recommendations for improvements. We will make sure buses are not traveling across St. Louis half empty.

Effective Tuesday, September 3rd, students may experience changes in their transportation routes as the newly revised system goes into effect. This update is essential to expand ridership capacity and address current challenges.

SLPS is actively developing additional routes in partnership with First Student, our main transportation provider. We understand the importance of keeping families informed, which is why we have created a dedicated Transportation FAQ page on our website at www.SLPS.org/FAQ. This "living document" is continuously updated to reflect the latest information and address any new questions that arise. Additionally, we welcome any further questions from families through our online submission form at www.slps.org/questions.

We appreciate the ongoing support and patience of our families as we work together to ensure a smooth transition to these new routes. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated as our drivers adapt to these changes.
