- o Mrs. Burton is retiring, but will still be around. She will work the summer academy for Metro Freshman.

- Metro summer academy for incoming freshman will be 4-6 weeks for all incoming 9th grade students with a focus on Mathematics, English, and writing. Students will be able to receive credit.

  - African American Literature will no longer be offered. AP English Literature is replacing it.
  - AP Chemistry will be offered.
