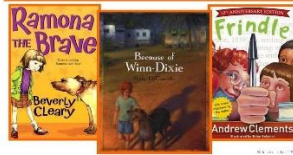
Speaking Activity

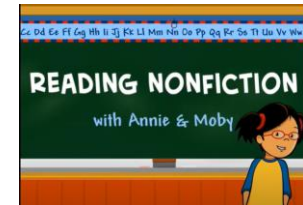
