The District's largest grants are provided through federal programs sources and include, but not limited to, Title grants, The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) grant for special education, the Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) grant, CARES (Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security) and funds under the Food and Nutrition programs. Trust grant funds are gifts, contributions, and donations used to fund specific programs and schools.
