Key Considerations for Title1 Fund Usage

Supplement, Not Supplant: Funds must add to, not replace, state and local funding sources.

Alignment with Comprehensive Needs Assessment: All expenditures must address identified needs and support strategies outlined in the school's Accountability Plan. Title I budget allocations must align with identified and appropriate expenditures.

Accuracy in Planning: Schools' EPEGs ESEA Building Level Plan submitted to DESE must accurately represent information identified in the needs assessment (Accountability Plans) and align with identified strategies and goals.

Expenses Categories & Examples

Instructional Materials and Resources

- Purchasing literacy resources such as decodable readers
- Math manipulative kits for hands-on learning

Academic Support Programs

- After-school tutoring sessions
- PD for teachers outside of their contracted day must aligned with accountability goals and strategies (Extra Service pay)
- Summer school programs focused on math and reading skill-building.

Parent and Family Engagement

- Hosting a Family Math Night to teach parents strategies to support learning at home
- Providing materials for parent workshops on supporting literacy at home
- Organizing transition workshops for parents of preschoolers entering kindergarten and 5th into middle school 8th into high school

School Climate and Culture

- Establishing a peer mentoring program to support social-emotional learning.
- Implementing Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) schoolwide.
- Purchasing resources in support of Social Emotional Learning

Transition and Postsecondary Preparation

Offering workshops on college application processes and financial aid.

Key Considerations for Title1 Fund Usage

Funding transportation for students to visit local colleges or attend career fairs.

Next Steps

1. Review Schools' ePeGs ESEA Plans and Current Budget Allocations:

- Ensure alignment between expenditures, Accountability Plans, and the Comprehensive Needs Assessment.
- Make necessary revisions in ePeGs and in terms of budget transfers to ensure compliance and effectiveness.

2. Meet with Network Principals:

- Review Title I budget expectations alongside ePeGs information, current budget allocations, and Accountability Plans.
- Provide clear guidance on allowable expenses and their alignment with school goals.

3. Provide Targeted Support:

 Offer individual support sessions for principals and school teams on effective use of Title I funds.

4. Monitor Implementation:

- Schedule follow-up meetings to address any challenges or questions from schools.
- Ensure ePeGs and budgets are updated no later than January 24, 2025 and that spending begins and continues in alignment with their plans.
