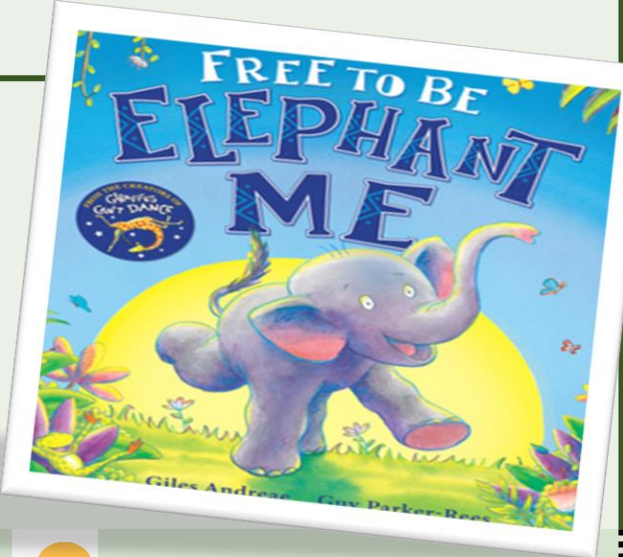



# Pre-k Choice Board

[Click here](#) to look at pictures of animals. Find a family member or friend to describe the animal to, and see if they can guess the animal!

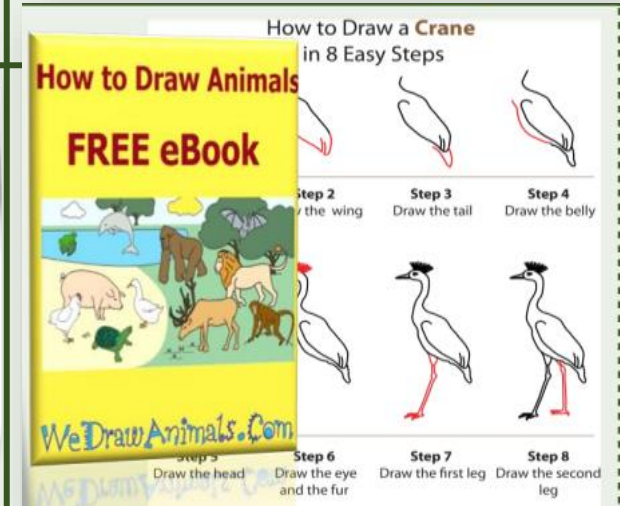
