Listening Activity

<u>Click here</u> to listen to "Pete the Cat: I Love My White Shoes." Share your favorite part of the story with an adult in your life and tell them about your favorite pair of shoes.



What was your favorite part of the story? "My favorite part was the singing. Pete sang, 'I love my white shoes, I love my white shoes.' Then, he stepped in a pile of strawberries, turning his shoes red, and sang, 'I love my red shoes, I love my red shoes.' My favorite pair of shoes are my boots because they keep my feet warm during the winter months!"

Listening Activity

<u>Click here</u> to listen to "The Giving Tree." Discuss with an adult in your life why the author chose the title, "The Giving Tree," and provide examples from the story to support your reasoning.



Why did the author choose the title, The Giving Tree? "I believe the author chose this title because the tree continually gives to the boy throughout the story. Initially, the tree provides friendship and then gives him apples. Later, the tree gives him all its branches, followed by the tree stump, and ultimately offers a place to rest."
