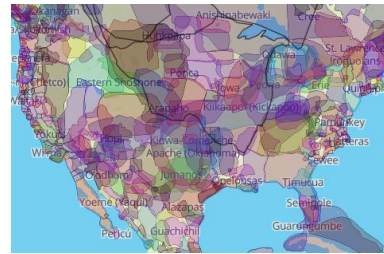
Listening Activity
