This list of criteria has been shared before, so hopefully this looks familiar. Seniors must meet the following to participate in graduation.

- Pass the required 24 credits by May 9, 2025. SchoolsPLP courses must be completed by May 1.
- 90% Hourly Attendance or higher
- Passed the Civics, US Constitution, and Missouri Constitution Tests
- Taken four End of Course (EOC) tests in English 2, Algebra 1, Biology, and Government
- Taken the ACT and the ASVAB or Accuplacer
- Completed the mandated CPR instruction
- Returned all technology (laptop & charger), books, sports uniforms.
- Senior dues (\$150) are paid in full and have no outstanding fees/fines.

CPR Instruction was provided last week. We will offer this one more time. The dates will be posted in the senior team.

Advanced Placement (AP) Exams

Students enrolled in Advanced Placement (AP) courses will take the corresponding AP exams in May. AP exams are administered nationwide, and the schedule is set by the College Board, the organization that makes the exams. Some exams are administered in the morning, while others are taken in the afternoon. These online exams are timed, and students cannot be admitted to the room once the exam has started. It is free for SLPS students to take these exams; however, College Board charges a "no show/late fee" of \$40 when students fail to take their AP exams. This fee will be charged directly to the student. Therefore, it is important that students arrive to take their exams as scheduled.

Senior Clearance

Seniors must complete the checkout process as the final step before being cleared for graduation. Senior clearance will take place May 12-16. During this time, seniors must meet with their counselors to ensure graduation requirements are met and exit surveys are completed. Students must return their district laptop and charger, pay all fees/fines and senior dues, and return sports uniforms and books. Students scheduled to take an AP exam will be cleared after completing their last exam. Students will receive their cap/gown/stole and six graduation tickets once they have completed all steps AND are cleared to participate in the ceremony.

Graduation Rehearsals

We will have a couple of practices leading up to the big day. One will be at Soldan, and we have scheduled time to practice at Harris-Stowe State University on May 14 at 10:30 am. **All graduating seniors are expected to participate in the upcoming rehearsals, even if their schedules are restricted.** Field trip

permission forms will be sent home with students closer to the date. Students may also drive directly to Harris-Stowe for the rehearsal.

Graduation Day

Students should arrive at Harris-Stowe State University by 1:30 pm with their cap, gown, stoles(s), and cords. The ceremony will begin promptly at 3:00 pm. Balloons are not allowed. All guests must have a ticket to attend the ceremony. Again, graduates will receive six tickets. If you do not need all the tickets provided, DO NOT SELL THE <u>FREE</u> TICKETS. You may GIVE extra tickets to another graduate or return them to the main office.
