Audition Protocol

Location

- Auditions will be held in the Dance Room at Central Visual and Performing Arts High School.

General Requirements

- All students will participate in a panel interview.
- Each student will have approximately 7–10 minutes to perform their piece/introduce their portfolio and go through the interview process.
- Bring a copy of your most recent report card and 2 letters of recommendation.
- Dress appropriately for your discipline.

Music (Instrumental/Vocal)	• Vocal: Students auditioning for vocal music will need to prepare a song to sing, demonstrate scales, and be prepared to perform an additional song if requested. • Instrumental: Students auditioning for instrumental music (piano, guitar, percussion, or band) must perform a 1–2 minute piece in any style and bring their instrument (except for piano and percussion, which are provided). • Students without an instrument must be prepared for an interview with the Fine Arts Department
Theater	• Prepare a 1-minute monologue from a published play. • Be ready for cold readings from a script provided during the audition.
Dance	• Perform a 1–2 minute solo in your preferred style. • Bring music on an aux-compatible device or email it beforehand. • – Be prepared to learn a short count of choreography • Wear proper dance attire (e.g, leotards, tights, jazz/ballet shoes). Hair should be neatly tied back.
Visual Art	• Submit a portfolio with 3–5 original works showcasing your skills. • Be prepared to discuss your work and artistic goals.
Post Audition Process	• Decisions will be communicated via email by December 20th. • Selected students will receive instructions on next steps.
