










ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

For the last three years, Colette Morton's classes have worked with Washington University professors in an effort to engage in cross curricula lessons.

Dan Giammar, (seen above with Deion Wilson), currently performs research that focuses on chemical reactions that affect the fate and transport of heavy metals, radionuclides, and other inorganic constituents in natural and engineered aquatic systems. He was recruited to speak to Gateway students by Alex Morales-Heil program manager for the Center for the Environment.

Morton met Morales-Heil almost ten years at an Environmental Book Club for high school teachers. Giammar's recent work investigated the removal of arsenic and chromium from drinking water, control of the corrosion of lead pipes, geologic carbon sequestration, and biogeochemical processes for remediation of uranium-contaminated sites.






