

The Real Estate Committee meeting convened in closed session on the date noted. The meeting opened at 3:05PM.

The following matters were discussed.

After considerable discussion, the committee recommended the following be brought before the SAB during the April 10, 2014 executive session for consideration.

- Committee recommends rejecting offer from CL Enterprises LLC for the Shepard School and Lot at 3425-99 Lemp and present counter for the Shepard School building only.
- 2) Committee recommends rejecting offer from 140 Lafayette LLC for the Lafayette School and present counter offer.
- 3) Committee recommends accepting a full price offer from Brinshore Development LLC for the Euclid School, subject to conditions/terms as discussed.
- 4) Committee recommends listing Clark School on the open market.
- 5) Committee recommends amending lease with People's Community Action Corporation to reflect addition of the 2nd floor to the "leased premises" at Cook School for an additional dollar amount as discussed.
