Additional Training

Office Administration Class

This class is available to all students. The curriculum will help prepare students for basic administrative skill used in modern offices. Special attention is placed on keyboarding and Microsoft Office skills as well as other job specific skills to include filing, office etiquette, and time management.

Pharmacy Tech Class

We offer a prep class, available to all students, that prepares you to take the certified pharmacy tech test. While we do not administer the test, we have a tailored curriculum that will help you succeed in doing so. There is a minimum placement test requirement for those interested.



17-24 Out of School Youth Employment Program

This is a special program for youth ages 17-24 only. Individuals must seriously be seeking employment, and willing to participate over and above what is required in other adult education classes. Students will determine a career interest, develop an employment plan, and participate in job experiences while working on HISET completion.

Job Placement

For all enrolled students, we offer job placement with partner career centers. Please choose the appropriate center closest to where you live. We can also provide guidance in resume and cover letter writing and locating labor market information electronically, for those students that need the assistance.

Work Keys Testing

Students interested in trades, as well as other employment programs, such as those offered in the community, we offer Work Keys testing to determine a student's level of employment readiness in basic areas such as workplace documents, applied math and graphic literacy.
