Guide to Understanding and Selecting WIDA Standards

To support multilingual learners in becoming proficient, all teachers working with ELLs need to focus on both content and WIDA English Language Development (ELD) standards. There are five WIDA ELD Standards that provide teachers with a connection between language development and content area learning.



Understanding WIDA Standards

WIDA ELD Standards Statements

- Standard 1: English language learners communicate for Social and Instructional purposes within the school setting.
 Language for Social Instructional Purpose (ELD-SI)
- Standard 2: English language learners communicate information, ideas, and concepts necessary for academic success in the content area of Language Arts.
 - Language for Language Arts (ELD-LA)
- Standard 3: English language learners communicate information, ideas, and concepts necessary for academic success in the content area of Mathematics.
 - Language for Math (ELD-MA)
- Standard 4: English language learners communicate information, ideas, and concepts necessary for academic success in the content area of Science.
 - Language for Science (ELD-SC)
- Standard 5: English language learners communicate information, ideas, and concepts necessary for academic success in the content area of Social Studies.

WIDA ELD standards are written using a reference code. The reference code includes:

- WIDA ELD Standards written as abbreviations (ELD-SI, ELD-LA, ELD-MA, ELD-SC, and ELD-SS);
- Grade level clusters (K, 1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-8, and 9-12);
- Key language uses (Narrate, Inform, Explain, and Argue). These Key Language Uses describe the prominent ways that language is used in schools across all disciplines. They help educators to provide focus and coherence as they are planning for integrating content and language.
- Modes of communication (interpretive and expressive). The interpretive communication mode encompasses listening, reading, and writing. The expressive communication mode encompasses speaking, writing, and representing.


Each WIDA ELD Standard outlines Language Expectations which include Language Functions and Language Features for content driven instruction, adding specificity to the WIDA ELD Standard statements and Key Language Uses.

- Language Functions highlight common patterns of language use, showcasing particular ways students might use language to meet the purposes of schooling. For example, a series of Language Functions is associated with the process of constructive fictional narratives, informing peers of newly gained knowledge, explaining phenomena, or engaging in scientific argumentation.
- Language Features are examples of various language resources that carry out specific Language Functions within the expectations, for example: different types of sentences, clauses, phrases, and words.

- What grade level cluster is this lesson designed for (KG, 1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-8, or 9-12)?
- What is the most prominent key language use for the lesson (Narrate, Inform, Explain, or Argue)?
- What communication mode is emphasized in the lesson (Interpretive, Expressive, or both)?
