Mr. Lischwe

- Thanks for the communication and feedback after the shooting at CVPA and Collegiate. We are
 doing many things to further secure the building and continue to make safety a huge priority. We
 appreciate everyone's flexibility.
- This Friday will be Wellness Day. Students will still be going to all their classes but they will be
 doing wellness activities that range from structured activities to fun activities. They are bringing in
 speakers from the community and have counselors on hand. They will have some fun no-cafeteria
 food. Goal is to send them off to Thanksgiving break with a good note.
- First Friday breakfasts are incredible and they are blown away. Helps with morale tremendously
- Big weekend for 3 Cross Country Boys and Girls, Volleyball Girls and Soccer Boys

Dr. Hollway

- Ask the parent community if they know of any devices being used to help with safety pass them
 on. They are looking at certain devices and methods for 3rd floor students to have an escape
 route. Funds are being used towards this. They redid their emergency plan and the SLPD is more
 actively involved to make sure they are aware of McKinley's plans.
- Maybe a small-scale Winter Dance for Middle School to replace the canceled Teen Town this fall.
- Request will be placed out to help install the new materials for the building (i.e. desks, flexible seating, etc) Goal to be done before students return from winter break.
- With the Beautification funds, they have purchased a banner which is waiting for better weather to install but that They have been trying to get the wraps for the building but the vendor delayed and now can't install until it is above 70 degrees.
- Mr. Nordike (Instructional coach) is leaving. There are potential internal applications which might cause another vacancy but it is being opened district wide. Since it is an administrator position, potential for parent involvement in the selection process.
- Spirit Wear The vendor site redid our crest and misspelled Middle (!) so the link was deactivated. Hope to have it up and running ASAP.
- Dr. Holloway wants to ensure that no matter what has happened, they are committed to academic
 instruction. Teachers are getting support for counseling services but still being held to providing a
 strong education to our students.

Q: Field Trips - Is that happening? Heard that there is a time constraint with buses that require a 9-1 timeframe by using our school buses.

A: We have been having a couple feed trips weekly. Grade levels and content subject teachers should be planning on them. For larger and/or longer trips, charter buses can be procured to get around this. About 50 HS students went to Cape

Increase in apps for High School They had 300 apps and can only take 75. Very excited to see more interest. Dr. Holloway gave Mr. Lischwe a shout out for planning on the shadow days.

Q: Will the 75 allotment remain in the future?

A: Really comes down to staffing and the amount of electives that can be offered.

Q: How are they selected?

A: Selection is based on transcripts, attendance, etc. Current 8th graders have to apply but they have the advantage of the administration already knowing them.

- We have 13,000 left over from prior years and we could vote to use that to cover the gap in our fundraising.
- A possibility would be to do a special fundraiser for individual projects like has been done for smart boards.
