

LE FUTUR DES VERBES IRRÉGULIERS

WHAT IS THE FUTURE

When you want to describe events that **WILL** happen in the future, use **le futur**.

Je **ferai** un stage de journalisme.
I **will do** a journalism internship.

Nous **irons** en Espagne.
We **will go** to Spain.

NOTE: In English, you use "will" before the verb, in French you use a tense (**beginning** + **endings**)

ÊTRE

Je serai	I will be
Tu seras	You will be
Il/Elle sera	He/She will be
Nous serons	We will be
Vous serez	You will be
Ils/Elles seront	They will be

NOTE:

c'est = this is
ce sera = this will be

FAIRE

Je ferai	I will do
Tu feras	You will do
Il/Elle fera	He/She will do
Nous ferons	We will do
Vous ferez	You will do
Ils/Elles feront	They will do

VOIR

Je verrai	I will see
Tu verras	You will see
Il/Elle verra	He/She will see
Nous verrons	We will see
Vous verrez	You will see
Ils/Elles verront	They will see

AVOIR

J' aurai	I will have
Tu auras	You will have
Il/Elle aura	He/She will have
Nous aurons	We will have
Vous aurez	You will have
Ils/Elles auront	They will have

NOTE:

Il y a = there is
Il y aura = there will be

ALLER

J' irai	I will go
Tu iras	You will go
Il/Elle ira	He/She will go
Nous irons	We will go
Vous irez	You will go
Ils/Elles iront	They will go

Note: All beginnings end with an -r, and all endings look like "avoir" in le présent.
