## **QUEL 270-271**

You use the interrogative adjective QUEL with a noun when you want to ask "what" or "which." Note that all forms of quel are pronounced the same even though they are spelled differently.

	MASCULIN	FEMININ
SINGULIER	<b>QUEL</b> vol quel avion	QUELLE compagnie quelle hôtesse
PLURIEL	QUELS vols quels avions	QUELLES compagnies quelles hôtesses

Attention: You need to know the gender of the nouns (words ending in -e, -tion, and -té are feminine, all others are masculine). Beware of the exceptions (highlight them and memorize them).

Essaie ça:
Tu fais un voyage? voyage? Ton avion part à heure? Ton avion part de porte? Pendant le vol, tu vas regarder film? Tu vas lire livres? Tu aimes compagnies?

What is your favorite color?
