





In-Store Program

The purpose of the in-store program is to help students access quality eye care when they miss their KVFL eye exam and/or need a replacement pair of glasses. This program is only eligible for students actively enrolled in a school district visited by the Kids Vision for Life St. Louis mobile vision clinic.

POLICIES

- The in-store program requires Crown Vision Center to check for Medicaid benefits and private vision insurance plans and will bill for an eye exam and/or materials if the benefit is eligible.
- If the student does not have any Medicaid or private insurance benefit, a \$20 fee will be collected for an eye exam and replacement or new glasses.
- Any student who misses their eye exam on the mobile vision clinic has 10 days to schedule an appointment with Crown Vision Center for an in-store KVFL eye exam.
- Students are only eligible for one free eye exam per year through the KVFL program, they will not be given a second free exam by visiting Crown Vision Center.
- Crown Vision will check and verify your child/student is enrolled in a KVFL school district before they can be seen.
- KVFL consent form is not required when visiting Crown Vision Center.
