

Title LA Annual Informational Meeting

The purpose is to inform parents or guardians of their school's participation in Title I.A, to explain Title I.A requirements and to state the right of parents or guardians to be involved.

School's Participation in Title I.A (SLPS Schools Operate School-Wide Programs)

SLPS receives an allocation from the federal government based on census poverty of children ages 5-17, children in neglected/delinquent institutions and foster children

The district/SLPS decides which buildings to serve with allocations.
