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Highlights

MPI Increases

- 22 MPI point increase in 3rd to 4th grade in ELA
- 20 MPI point increase in 4th to 5th grade in Math
- 77 MPI point increase in 8th grade math to 9th grade Algebra I



Continuous Improvement

- Continued with above 90% in Follow-Up – Positive Placement (100% of the points)
- CCR Results are in the 50% range for both College Placement assessment or Dual Enrolled & Dual Credit
- Earning 50% of the points in graduation rate
