VIRTUAL PROGRAMMING

Technology Equity

- ❑ 1:1 for K – 12th grade
 - ❑ K-8 iPads – **15,000**
 - ❑ Dell Laptops - **6,000**
- ❑ Hot Spots (with data limits) for any family in need – **4,000**
- ❑ Distribution at school sites between **8/24 – 9/4**



INSTRUCTION AND TECHNOLOGY PLANS

VIRTUAL PROGRAMMING

Technology Inventory Coordinator (TIC)

- Arranging to pick up or delivery of devices to school
- Inventory of devices in the school
- Distribution of devices
- Tracking of devices that are damaged and/or repaired
- Work with Technology Department to get items repaired
- Work with Technology Department to replenish 10% inventory
- Work with families when students withdraw to retrieve their equipment
- Work at end of school year to retrieve all checked out equipment to prepare for the 2021-22 school year

EARLY CHILDHOOD OPTIONS

OPTION 1

- Modified virtual schedule that adheres to the synchronous and asynchronous schedule
 - ie: 2 hour increments with time built-in to the schedule for constructive play and project construct methodology

OPTION 2

- Pre-K webpage – accessibility to online resources created by teachers
 - Webpage that is updated regularly throughout the school year
 - No virtual options
 - Parents will have access to the webpage for online resources to use at their discretion



***iPad will be available to families, beginning September 1**

WEEKLY EXPECTATIONS:

Teachers will :

- Post 5 suggested activities on teacher webpage
- Post 3 read aloud videos
- Post 2 lesson videos per week on teacher webpage
- Send feedback to families from photos or videos submitted of completed activities
- Teachers will be required to have weekly check-ins with students as communication logs will be maintained and reviewed by Early Childhood office and school leadership teams



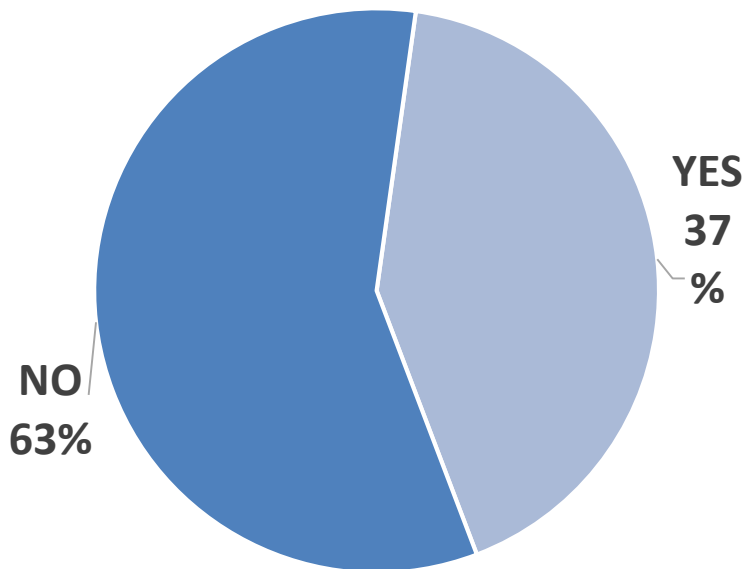

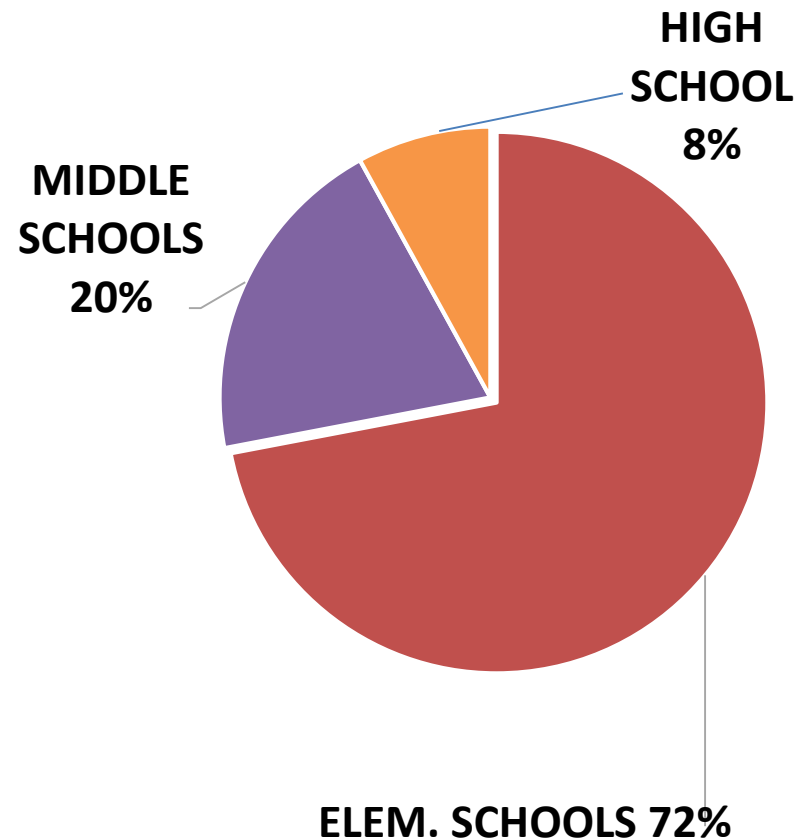

TRANSPORTATION

- 31 Special Education Routes
- 130 Regular Routes
- One Student Per Seat
- 1/2 Mile Distance Eligibility
- Closest Corner Bus Stop



FOOD SITES

- 18 Food Distribution Sites
- Parent/guardian pick up food from instructional support center where the student is not enrolled
- Monday will be the one-day pickup
- Parents will be provided a 5 day meal kit which includes breakfast and lunch

EARLY CHILDHOOD INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT CENTERS

- Stix Elementary – 133 students (4 Year olds only)
- Wilkinson Elementary – 74 students (K-2 grade only)
- 10:2, no more than 150 enrolled (P4s only)
- Before and After care will be offered
- 1 classroom teacher
- 2 teacher assistants (classroom support, arrival/dismissal procedures)
