School Year 2023-2024 Preparation

- Finance will authorize positions in **April 2023** to allow staffing team to begin appointing new staff in SAP as soon as possible.
- The Staffing Team will begin training/bootcamp to acclimate new HR personnel to the work and to create consistency in execution of processes.
- Beginning **March 2023**, onboarding deadlines have been implemented for new hires to complete their paperwork and tasks to create a more efficient entry process.
- New hire newsletters will be created and distributed beginning in May to keep new hires excited about joining the SLPS family through the summer months (retention effort).
