CCR Programming Review



Early College Academy (ECA)

- 2021-2022
 - 30 Juniors, 26 Seniors, 26 Associates Degrees Earned
- 2022-2023
 - 25 Juniors, 29 Seniors, 27 Associates Degrees Earned

Learn and Earn Internship Program

- Implemented in SY 21-22
- Over 500 students participated in paid internships
- Expanding into the summer with an additional 100-150 interns with remaining funds from the City of St. Louis

College Admission Advisors

- Combination of College Admission Specialists (SLPS) and Missouri College Advising Corps staff assigned to high schools
- Responsible for supporting seniors and facilitating completion of the CCR tracker for their school
- Required staffing support from CCR staff during 22-23

CCR Programming Review



Freshman Success Teams

- 2021-2022
 - GPA 2.0 and above – 76%, GPA below 2.0 – 24%
- 2022-2023
 - GPA 2.0 and above – 71%, GPA below 2.0 – 29%
- Note: 73% of the 2021-2022 Freshmen had a GPA \geq 2.0 at the end of the academic year. After Summer Learning, the number increased to 76%. The data for 2022-2023 will be recalculated after the conclusion of Summer Learning 2023.

SLPS – SLATE 1st Annual Career Fair

- First career fair focused specifically on up to 200 seniors who expressed a desire to enter the workforce after graduation
- Over 150 seniors participated
- On-the-spot applications and, in some cases interviews
- Looking to expand opportunity next year

CTE By the Numbers

- CTE Approved Programs = **27**
- CTE Student Enrollment Numbers (Grades 9-12) = **2200**
- CTE Teachers = **62**
- CTE class(es) / programming offered in **all 11 HS buildings**

CTE 23-24 Focus

- Curriculum project focused on aligning all 27 programs with industry standards and Industry Recognized Credentials (IRCs)
- Collaborate with Academic Office leaders to support Phase II implementation of K-12 Computer Science Pathway
- Develop and implement partnerships to support new programs and to bolster current programs

Looking Ahead to 2023-2024



Early College Academy (ECA)

- Expand incoming cohort to 42 students
- Targeted summer support for students from comprehensive high schools to increase participation rates

Open Ranken Construction Center

- Over 30 11th grade students from across the district are currently signed-up/enrolled for SY 23-24
- Wait list created

Boeing Aviation Training

- Boeing/StL Community College will teach Boeing's Pre-employment program to 2nd semester 12th grade students at Gateway STEM HS
- Graduates will receive dual credit; hired at Boeing at \$24 per hour upon graduation
- Full tuition and benefits available immediately upon hire
- Boeing opportunity to be provided to all SLPS graduates at-large in the summer after graduation

Looking Ahead to 2023-2024



Social Emotional Learning – Rethink ED

- Implementation of K-12 Social Emotional Learning program piloted last school year
- Training for school leaders, teachers and support staff scheduled for Summer Leadership Institute (July 2023)

Beaumont CTE Programs

- Focused enrollment effort in spring 2023
- Increase in enrollment from 52 to 140 students

Freshmen Success Teams (FST)

- Establish quarterly benchmarks and districtwide meeting protocol
- Provide training at Summer Leadership Institute (SLI) to school leaders

Learn and Earn Internship Program

- **SLPS is emerging as the industry/regional leader for paid internship programs**
- Refine partnerships and presence in the workforce conversation for the region
