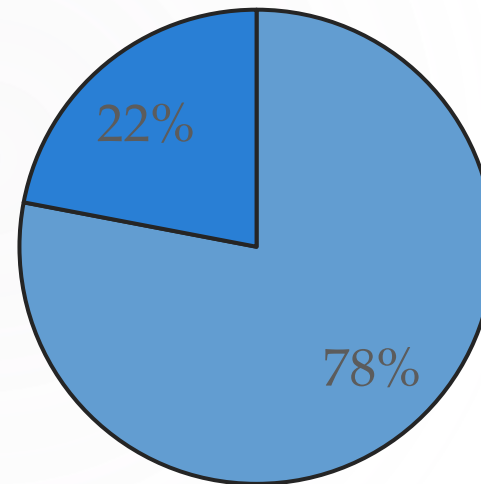

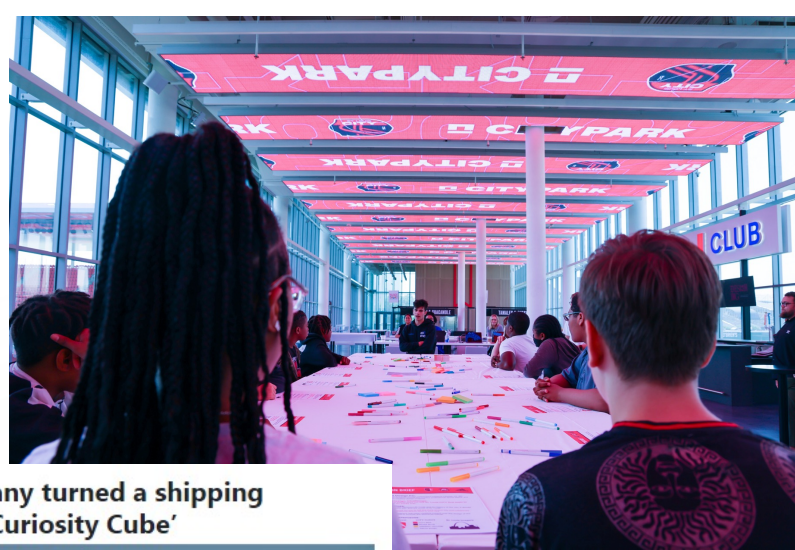

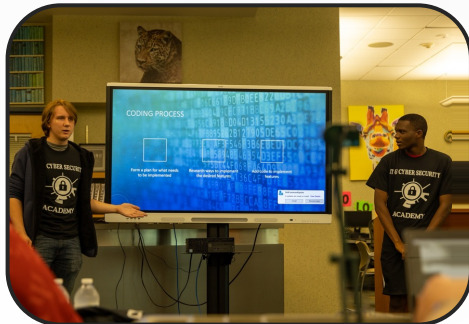

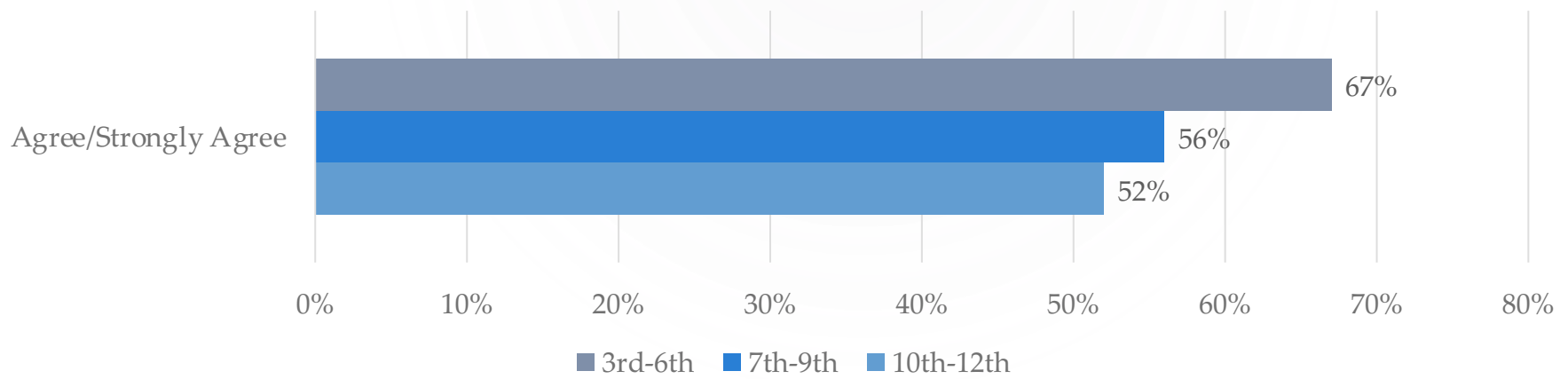

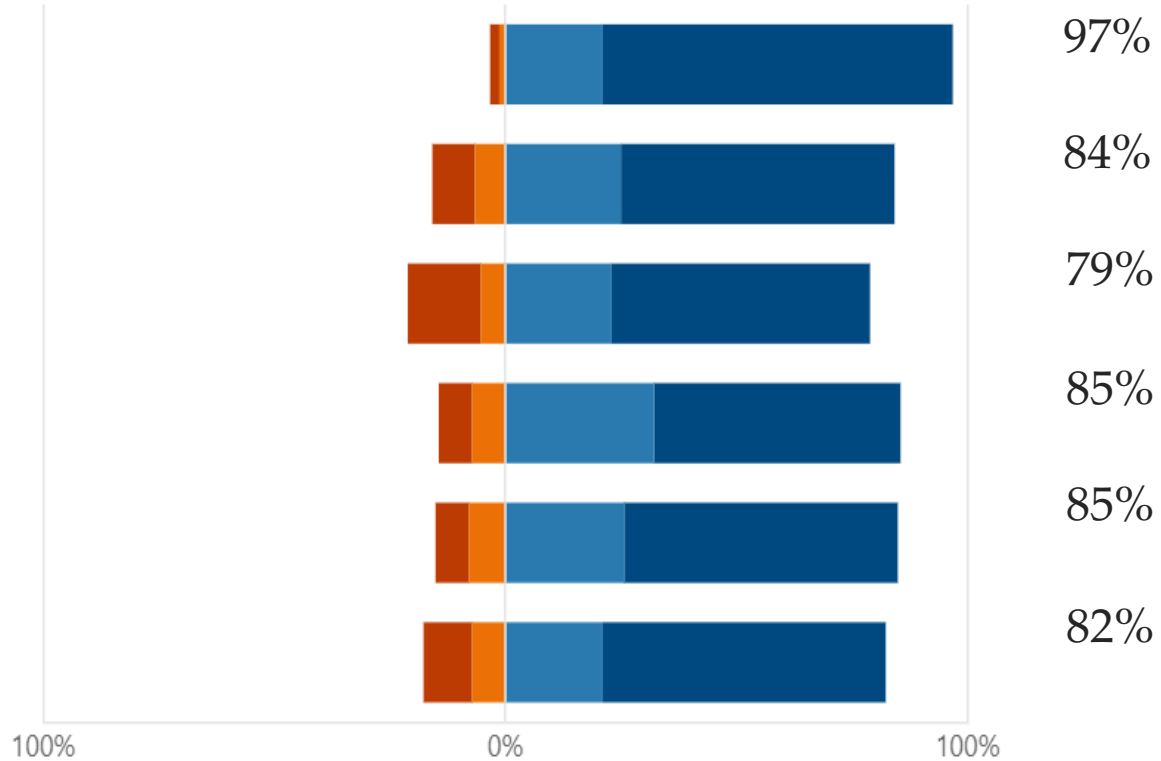

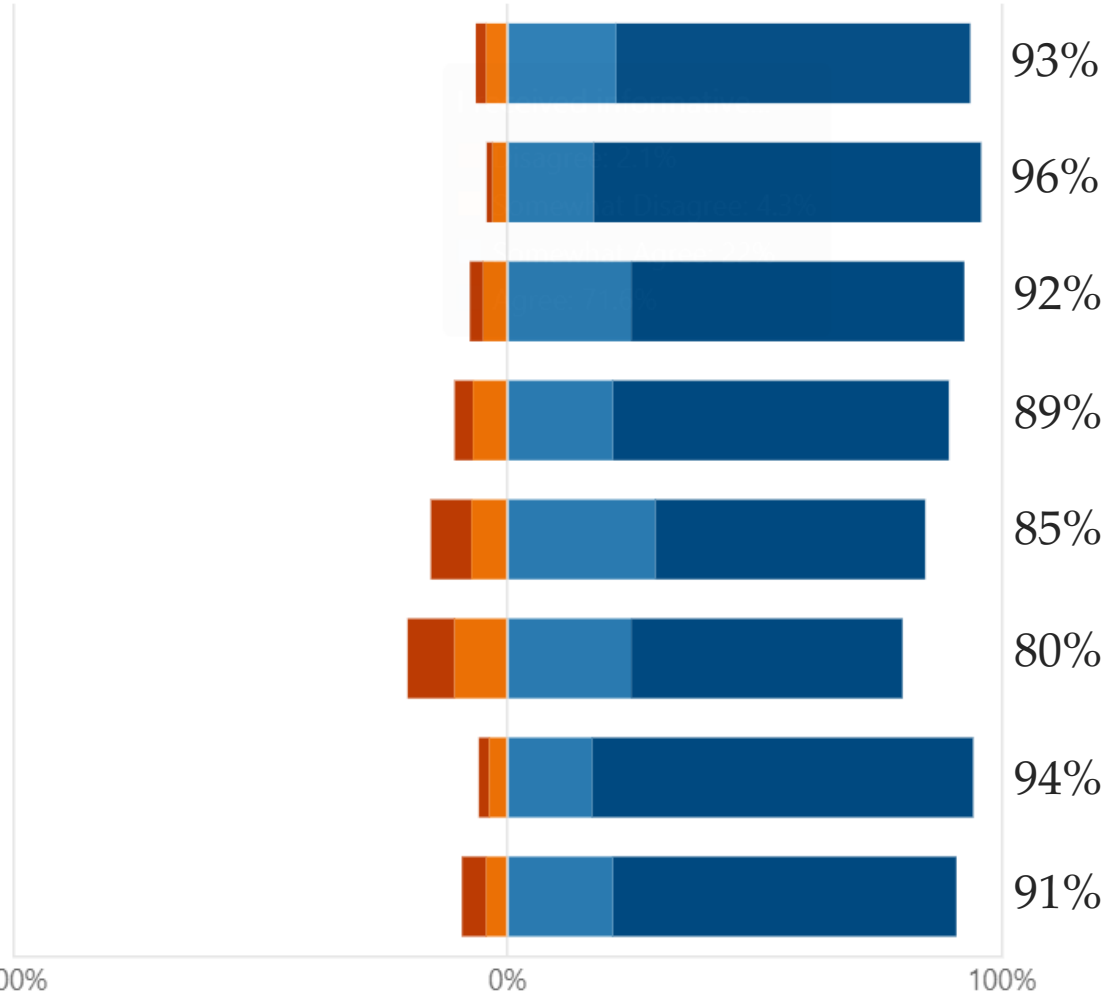

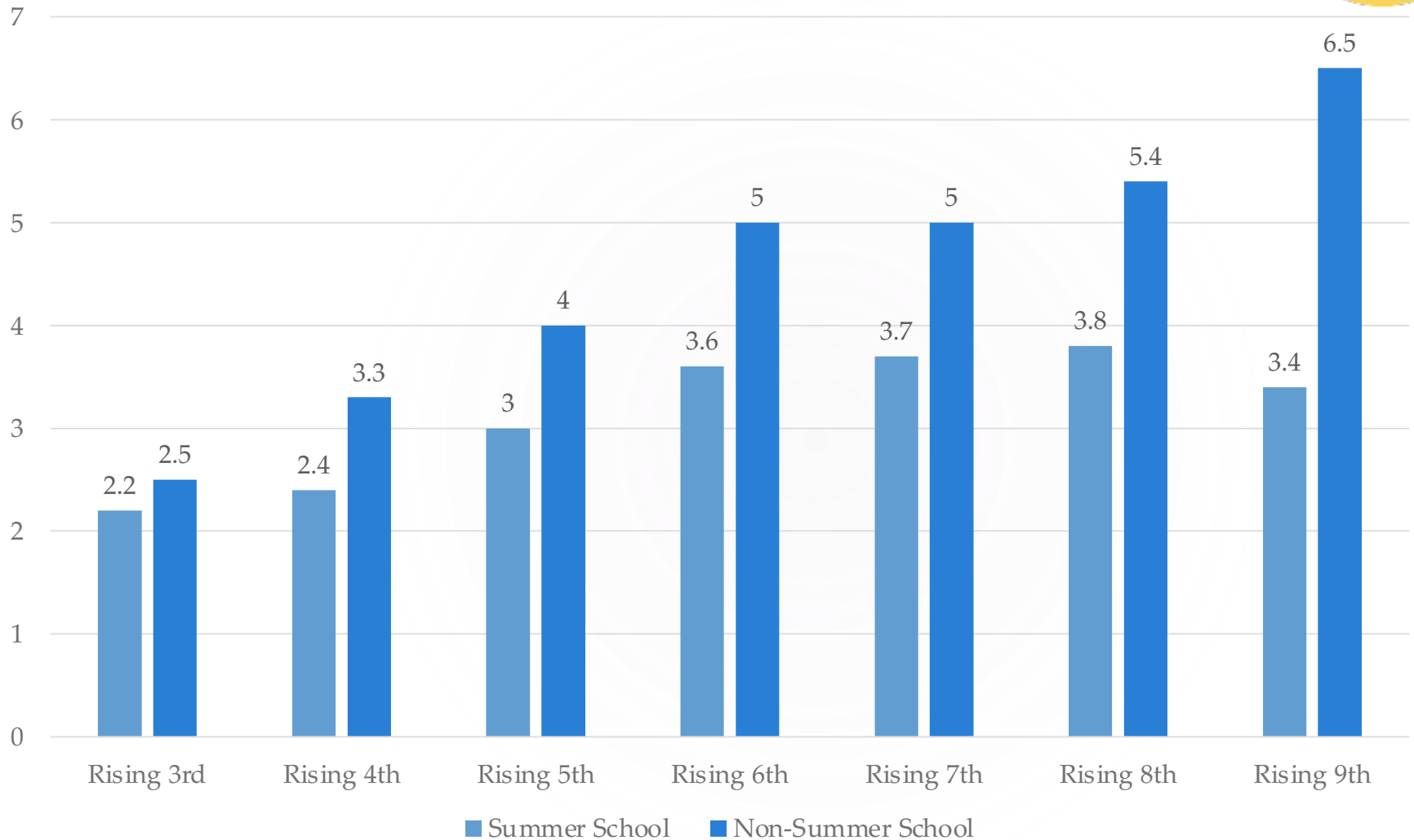


Challenges & Lessons Learned

- Wide-range of programming offered and number of sites
- Transportation issues during the first week and air quality/head advisory during last week adversely impacted student attendance
- STAR Reading growth was minimal based on pre- and post-assessments, however, data suggests summer learning kept the “summer slide” from expanding achievement gaps
- Gap between students registered/recommended and participation
- Less demand than anticipated for in-person high school electives

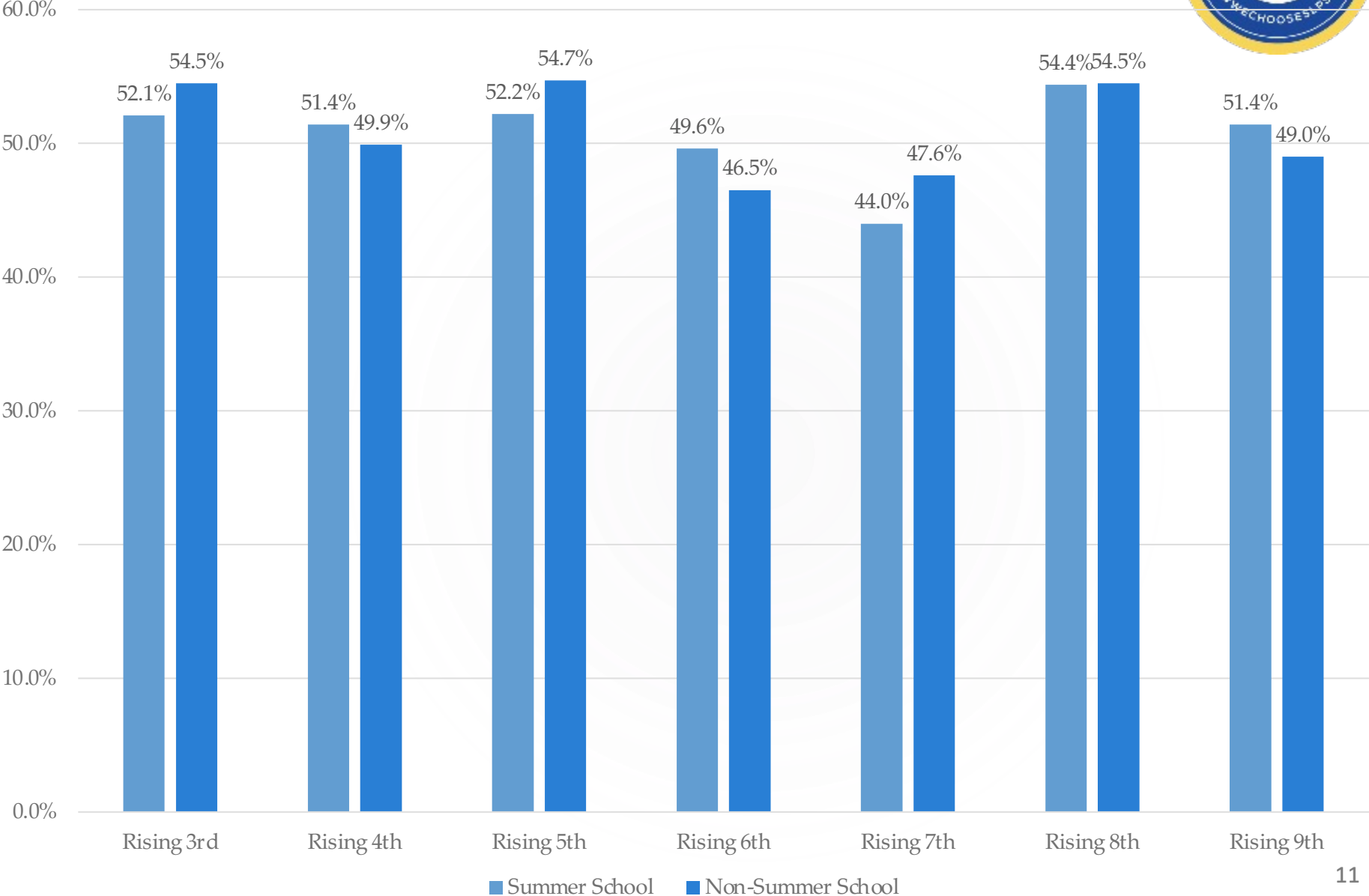


STAR Reading Mean Grade Equivalent Spring 2023 Summer School vs. Non-Summer School Students





STAR Reading Percentage of Students with At/Above Average Growth from Spring-Fall 2023 Summer School vs. Non-Summer School Students

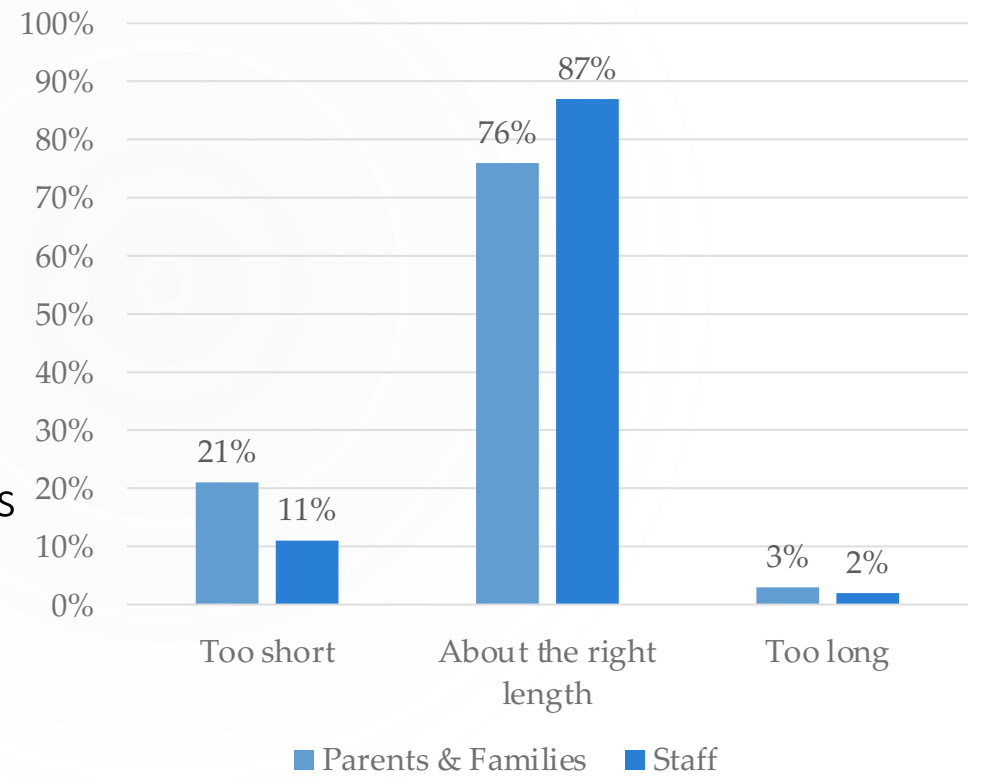




2024 Planning Considerations
