2. Commenters may take an **available** seat in the room (**up to 20**).
3. Public Comments will occur at the **end of each** Board Meeting (information can be submitted to the Board in writing).
4. Each commenter will have up to **three (3) minutes** to address the Board.
5. Each commenter must remain respectful and **refrain from speaking derogatorily about anyone** (do not use names).
6. There will be 30 minutes allotted for **all comments**. If you were not called to speak, you might submit your information in writing or return to the next scheduled meeting with a priority number.
7. Only one individual or group should speak to the **same point on one topic**.
