MAP-A - MAP Alternative

GLA - Grade Level Assessment

- ELA: 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>
  - Writing prompt 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>
- Math: 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>
- Science: 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>

EOC - End-of-Course

- Algebra I, Biology, English II, and Government
