READING TEACHERS AND INDIVIDUALIZED READING SUCCESS PLANS

- Reading teachers work in 27 Title I elementary schools across the district supporting students in K-5.
- The SLPS Individualized Reading Success Plan (IRSP) is a tool designed to document intensive reading instruction, interventions and benchmark growth for students with identified reading deficiencies.





LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT: STARTER TRAINING

- On November 1, 2023 all school leaders received training from the Renaissance Team on the STAR Reading and Math reports.
- School leaders learned about the different reporting tools embedded within STAR and their alignment to state standards.
- The training explored goal setting using the STAR assessment.
