# CURRENT STATUS OF DISTRIBUTION



92% of our students have a district device

- 3% opt out
- The remaining 5% have a device that they keep in the classroom



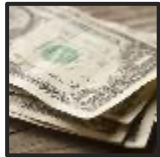
We continue to work with families on device returns and payment plans  
Online payment opportunity is helpful



There is less of a need for hot spots – now that we have iPads with cellular

- Only 250 at high school level needed a hot spot

# CURRENT STATUS OF PROJECTS



## E-RATE FUNDING

- replaced over 2,500 Wi-Fi appliances in all locations



## Bandwidth

- Monitoring of network speed is sufficient at current rate



## ESSER II Funding

- provided over 700 Smart and/or Promethean Boards in classrooms
  - This reduces the number of Help Desk tickets
  - Provides the latest technology for classroom engagement

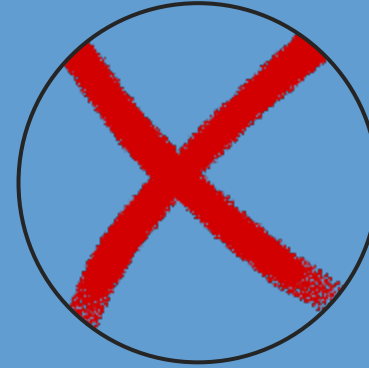
