TAX RATE NOTICE

A hearing will be held on Monday, September 22, 2025 at 6:00 P.M., at the St. Louis Board of Education Administration Office, 801 N. 11th Street, St. Louis, MO 63101, on the first floor in room 108, at which time citizens may be heard on the property tax proposed to be set by the Board of Education of the City of St. Louis. The tax rates are set to produce the revenue, which the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, shows to be required from the property taxes. Each tax rate is determined by dividing the amount of the revenue needed by the assessed valuation. The result is multiplied by 100 (one hundred) so that the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100 valuation.


