



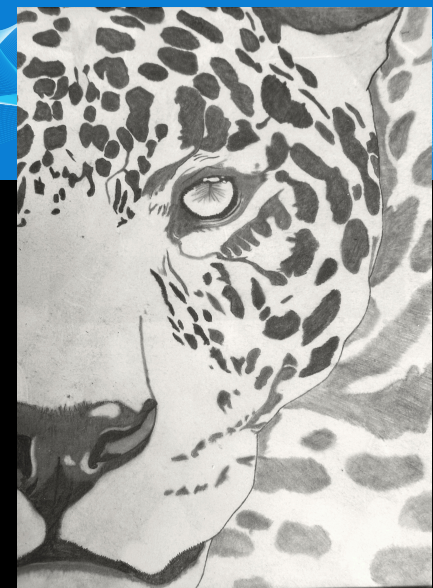

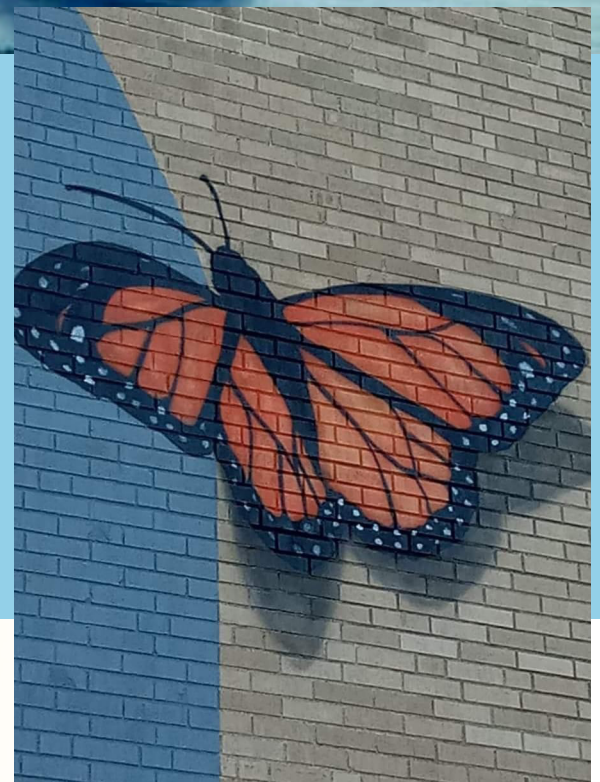




# Bill Burton

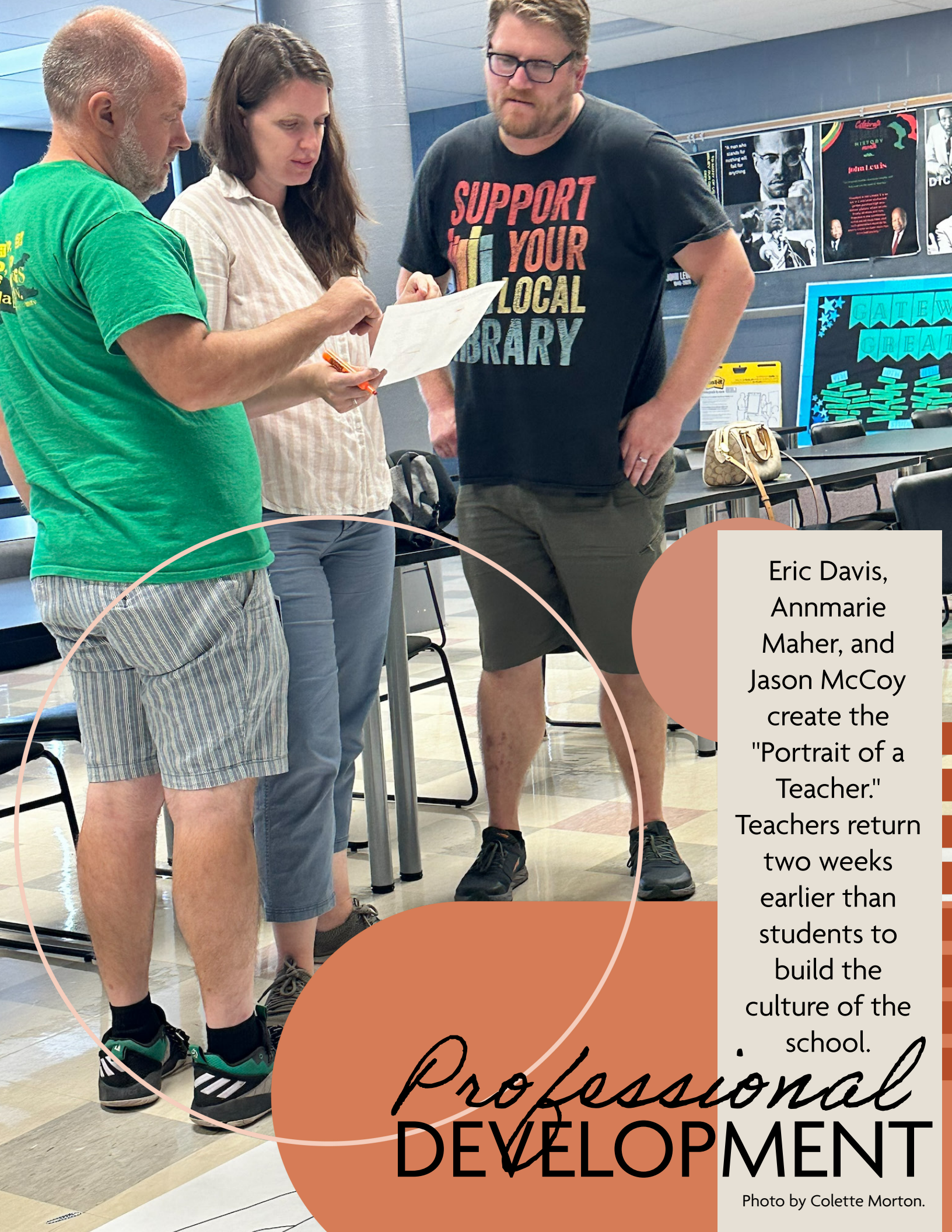
# LADDER THIEVES FROM THE SLAVES

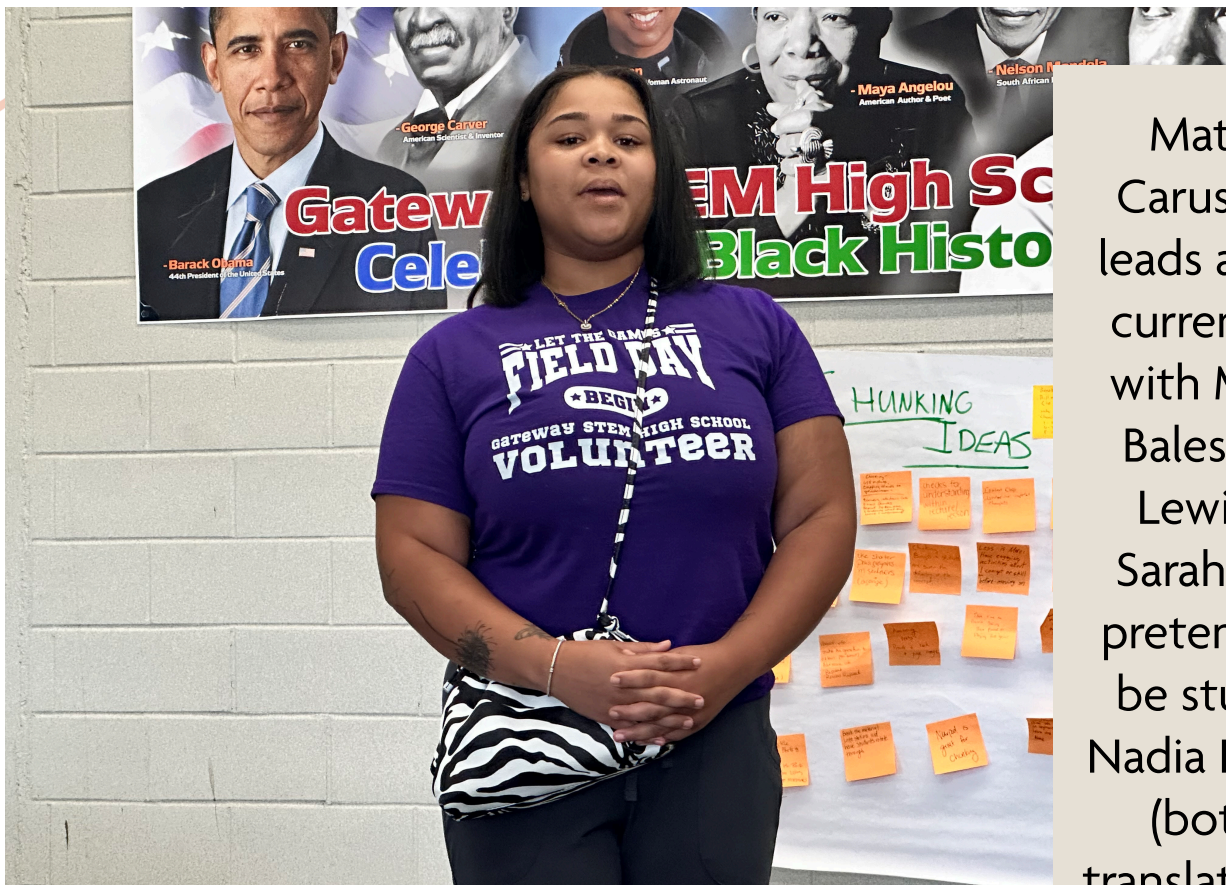
