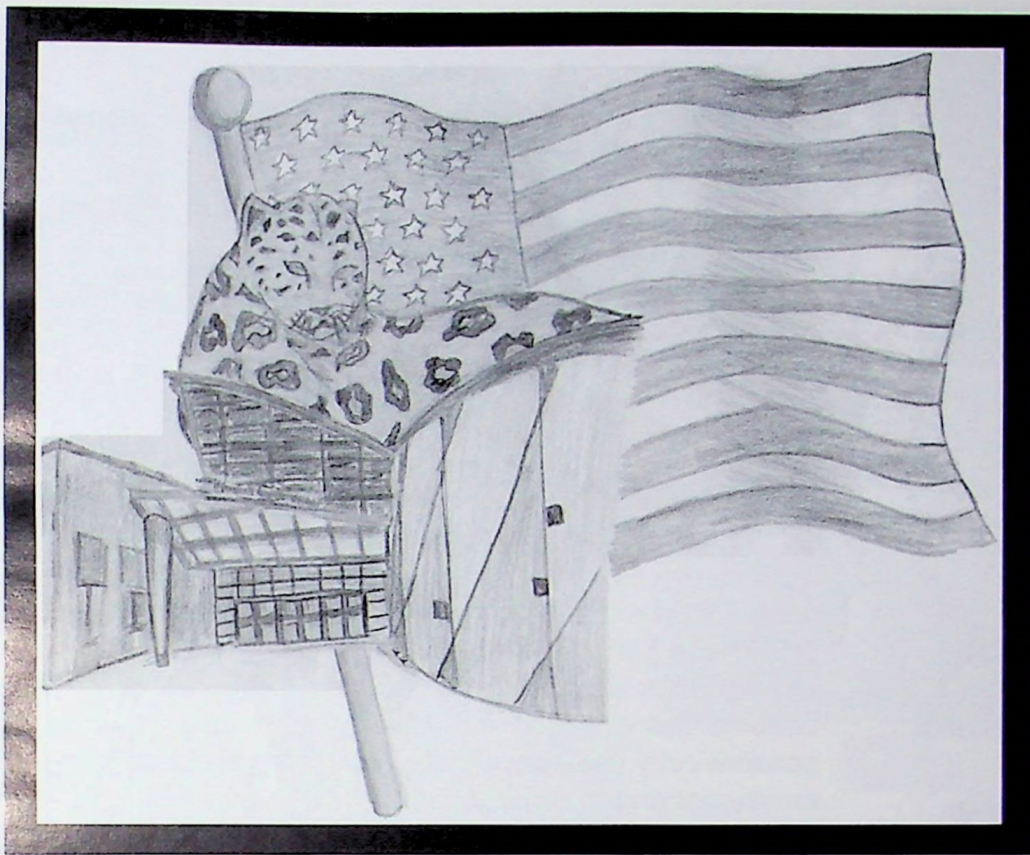

... and what a great one it turned out to be!

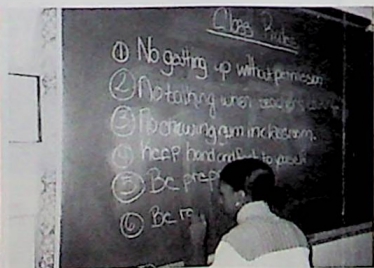
